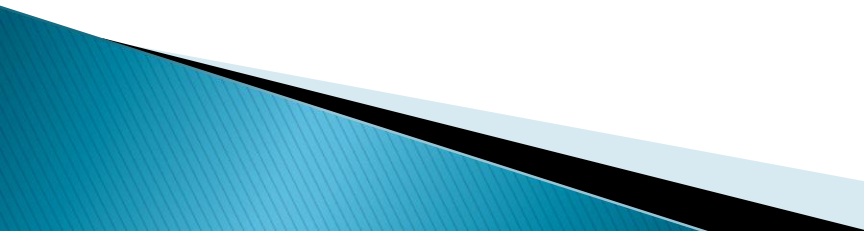

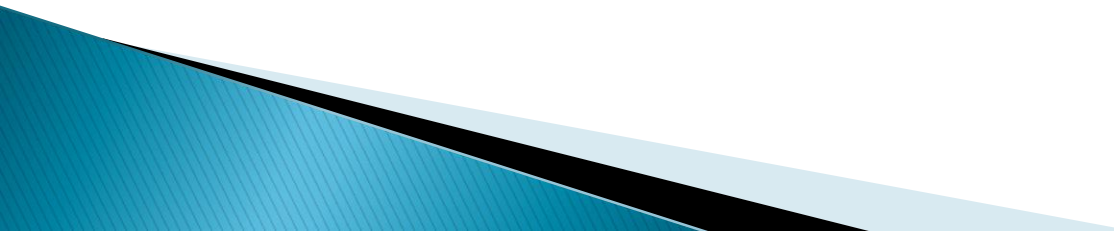
Linking S&T Analyses to Actions

- ▶ Selection of topics and structure of future activities should be informed by results of S&T analyses
 - Demonstrate and gain experience with how to use evidence to drive actions
 - Practice what we preach
 - ▶ Link S&T analyses to policy and research collaboration dialog
 - Include discussion of analyses in thematic workshops

Some Success Factors

- ▶ Not just subject areas but specific problems must be of interest to both sides
- ▶ SEA and EU research teams must be approx equally matched. Each must bring something essential to the mix
 - Chikungunya virus research by Dr. Lisa Ng and Dr. Pierre Roques
 - Implies need for capacity building
- ▶ Understanding and leveraging local context is critical

Highlight SEA Research Excellence

- ▶ Spotlight booklet is a good start
 - ▶ Can also produce analyses that could be kept with and maintained by the NCPs
 - ▶ Include young scientists
